

Carbon emissions 2024

In year 2024 Magni Mundi and tourism in southern Finland have finally mostly recovered from pandemic. We are happy to see our customers returning and new customers finding our services.

It means, that compared to our emissions in 2022 and 2023, total emissions have gone up, but per customers emissions are lower than before. Most of our emissions come from Scope 3. We have worked towards lowering our Scope 3 emissions by helping small, local businesses towards lower emissions and using STF-labelled accommodation and transportation when possible.

Our office emissions have stayed approximately the same since 2022 even with addition of part-time office worker working from home office in 2024. Magni Mundi doesn't own property or rent office space. Work-related travel has increased since 2022, because in 2024 Magni Mundi expanded to Tampere, so we have had to travel between Turku and Tampere more than before. There is a good train connection between the cities, so travel emissions are relatively low per travel.

Our total emissions are measured in kilograms, not tons. Magni Mundi has a sustainable foundation, so there isn't much we can do to lower our scope 1 and 2 emissions. We focus on lowering Scope 3, meaning emissions produced by our partners.
